Delivering for commuters

As public transport services continue to improve, the NSW Government is delivering a fairer, simpler and easier fare structure. This will make travel on public transport more attractive, particularly for long distance and multi-modal commuters.

New MyZone fares

Commuters want a simpler and easier way to travel. The NSW Government's new fare structure will use existing ticketing equipment to create a simpler and easier fare structure.







The new structure, called MyZone, will streamline ticket products for public and private bus users, and the most commuters will pay will be \$57* per week, regardless of where or how often they travel on the network.

Private bus passengers will have multi trip tickets, valid for ten trips with no expiry date, for the first time. These new tickets will be valid on both private and government buses. Three new MyMulti passes will provide unlimited travel on buses and ferries, plus travel in three train zones (see map overleaf).

We're making it easier to select the ticket that is right for your trip. This will make it easier for you to travel across Sydney, on any type of public transport.

New MyZone tickets will be on sale from April 2010.

How fares are getting simpler from 18 April 2010


-  **5 rail fare bands** will replace the current 20+
-  **3 bus fare bands** will replace the current 5
-  **2 ferry fare bands** will replace the current 5 (Sydney Ferries only)
-  **3 new 'all you can travel' MyMulti passes** will be introduced, based on geographical zones
-  **Standard tickets that can be used on both** private buses and State Transit Authority buses (excluding Newcastle Buses)
-  **With MyMulti, you will pay no more than \$57* per week regardless of how much you travel**

New tickets for rail, bus and ferry


New fares will apply across the entire CityRail, State Transit Authority buses and ferries, Sydney Ferries and private bus networks in the Greater Sydney Region, including the Blue Mountains, Illawarra, Central Coast and the Hunter. Newcastle time-based fares and passes will remain.
